# Roof Damage at 402 1st Ave West (Parsonage):

- We spoke to the insurance agent.
- By unanimous consent, Barb will be the point person to talk with the adjuster and will consult with Jeff.
- We've determined that a tarp is not necessary at this point.

## Landscaping:

- Action approval requested by the Rooted and Rising Climate Crew:
  - 1. Place the planters in a diamond shape in the triangle, bordered by the sidewalk and the parking lot
    - 1.
- The crew is working with the Community Garden Project through the Extension Office.
- They will use the water from the church.
- 2. Plant 5-6 nanny berry shrubs on 2nd St. side, from the sidewalk into the grotto to the east corner of the building
- 3. Plant 2 red maples one in the middle of the planters, a second near the playground area.
- 4. Reseed an 8x8 section of ground on the south side of the building with a turf suggested by Extension Office. This will be a demonstration plot.
- The committee approves the action of this crew with our feedback; namely, limit the number of shrubs, the planters are not attractive (Jeff!) and there were many hoses offered.

### Architectural Proposal:

- We've received one proposal from ATSR who have visited the church.
  - Pros:
    - 1. The initial cost of \$6,000 is reasonable.
    - 2. ATSR will act as the general contractor.
    - 3. We will have a master plan for the growth of this church.
  - Cons/Questions:
    - 1. Are transportation costs included or extra?
    - 2. What does the 7% cover?
    - 3. How often would the general contractor be on sight?
    - 4. Does the contract expire on a particular date?
    - 5. Will the contract have an exit clause?
- Action: John will contact ATSR with questions plus to request a sample contract before we go the board for approval. John will call on a few of their references.
