Architecture Contract with ATSR

- 7. **J**eff expressed concern for the potential lack of innovative element that ATSR might provide, especially when it comes to the building exterior.
- 8. John will write up an overview, circulate for feedback, and we will get that out via Mail Chimp, Church Announcements. Barb will make the announcement on this Sunday. Pastor Enno will make the announcement on June 11 at the Pride Worship Service in Harbor Park.
